

Option to Advance Plays

Play 1. Following a made goal by Team A with 49.9 seconds remaining in the 4th quarter, Team B immediately calls timeout. May Team B advance the ball to the 28 ft throw-in spot in the frontcourt on either side?

Play 2. If in Play 1, Team A is the team calling the timeout, does Team B have the option to advance the ball to the frontcourt?

Play 3. A1 secures a rebound in her backcourt with 1:05 remaining in the 4th quarter. She holds the ball for 6 seconds when the head coach of Team A calls a timeout. Does Team A have the option to advance the ball to the frontcourt?

Play 4. A1 is dribbling in her frontcourt with 30 seconds left in the 4th quarter. B1 steals the ball, does not dribble or pass and calls a timeout. May Team B advance the ball to their frontcourt at the 28 ft mark?

Play 5. Team A inbounds the ball after a made basket by Team B. While A1 is dribbling in her backcourt:

- a) she is fouled by B1 before the bonus is in effect
- b) B1 commits a kicking violation
- c) B1 causes a held ball and the arrow favors Team A
- d) there is a timing or scoring mistake
- e) the official has an inadvertent whistle
- f) A2 is injured, bleeding or has lost a contact lens

If Team A calls a timeout in any of these scenarios, may they advance the ball?

Play 6. A1 is dribbling in her frontcourt when the ball is deflected by B1

- a) into Team A's backcourt and A1 retrieves it.
- b) into Teams A's backcourt and the ball goes out of bounds. If Team A calls a timeout, may they advance the ball in either play?
